Basic Instructor Certification Course (Level 1)

The Basic Instructor Certification Course is the foundation of the IDI and successful completion is required to progress in the IDI Program. This entry level course, or its equivalent, will provide the apprentice instructor with the basics of contemporary adult learning methodologies, paralanguage, critical thinking, taxonomies of learning, and presentation and platform skills. Two other courses are considered to be an equivalent to this basic course - the Academy Instructor Certification Course (AICC) and the Institute of Criminal Investigations (ICI) Instructor course (ICI-I)

AICC - OR

24 hours of instructor development *and* view the POST DVD on the Academy Process, take “Learners First” on the POST Learning Portal *and* be signed off by an Academy Director using the POST competency verification form 2-123

ICI Instructor (ICI-I)

Must also complete two online POST Learning Portal Classes: “Best Practices of Good Training” *and* “Target Your Teaching”. Completion of these will allow entry into Level II of IDI
